Completed Scholarship Applications will be accepted through <u>3pm Thursday APRIL 27, 2023 to be eligible for consideration</u>.

Incomplete applications cannot be accepted and will be returned.

All scholarship applications are evaluated by the Radtke Fund's three-member review board and awards are kept strictly confidential; recipients are awarded scholarships based on the criteria below and supporting documents.

Scholarships will be <u>awarded by Friday May 5, 2023</u> and notifications to all applicants will be sent in writing by U.S. Mail. Recipients will receive a 2023 OYC Junior Sailing Program enrollment application *at that time*. Radtke Fund Scholarship recipients must complete and return their 2023 JSP enrollment applications to the Orleans Yacht Club no later than Tuesday, May 30, 2023 to guarantee placement or the scholarship award will be forfeit. Scholarships may only be redeemed for consecutive weeks and used in the year they are awarded.

Qualifying recipients are awarded scholarships based on the following criteria:

- Demonstrating a clear financial need: The Fund Directors recognize that family hardships and financial status can differ and change from year to year. The requester shall demonstrate a clear financial need each year when requesting scholarship support and may determine how and what information they present regarding financial matters. We encourage the applicant to be forthcoming and open when conveying the need for financial aid. Insufficient presentation may cause rejection or a follow-up request by the fund Directors for further clarification or additional information.
- 2. Must be between eight and eighteen years old by June 26, 2023 (3rd grade through high school senior)
- 3. Having a desire to learn to sail, or
- 4. Having a desire to continue building upon previous sailing experience
- 5. Being enrolled in either the Nauset Regional School system or elsewhere
