### Program Requirements

*Sailing is an involved sport and the OYC strongly recommends a minimum of two consecutive weeks of enrollment to maximize time on the water and put to use the variety of new skills.*

**Start Dates/Program Ages:** New classes begin weekly and students are required to start their classes at the beginning of the week. The sailing program is open to children aged 8-18 (students must be 8 years old on or before June 1).

**Swimming:** Participants must have basic swimming skills and be able to swim unaided for ten yards and tread water for 3 minutes (without a life jacket). A short swim test will be given to all Beginners on their first day of class.

**Equipment Required:** All participants must have & wear their own U.S. Coast Guard approved lifejacket (PFD) at all times. Closed-toed shoes (NOT flip-flops) and 25+ SPF sunscreen are also required to be worn at every class. Participants should also bring a towel, hat, long-sleeve shirt, windbreaker, sun-glasses, water and/or non-refrigerated snacks PLUS a change of clothing. Many participants wear bathing suits under their shorts & tee shirts.

Sailing in different weather conditions is an integral part of the learning experience and many classes are conducted in the rain, so students are expected to attend classes and be dressed appropriately for the weather.

**Note:** The OYC offers a reasonably priced lunch menu between 11:30a.m. -2:00p.m. for OYC Members, JSP students and their families. This is not a part of the sailing program.

### Class Level Descriptions

**Beginner:** This class is for students with little or no sailing experience. Students will be taught the basics of sailing (*wind direction, points of sail, knot tying, rigging and boat handling*) using two classes of boats.

**Intermediate:** In this class, sailors develop their previous beginning sailing experience and continue to grow more comfortable on the water. A brief introduction to racing is taught.

**Skipper:** Sailors further hone their sailing skills with advanced concepts and drills. They are encouraged to participate in program Opti Regattas on Thursdays or outside of the Club. An introduction to the Club 420s may be taught when appropriate.

**Advanced:** Sailing and racing skills learned previously are now applied to the Club 420s - a slightly larger, faster racing sailboat. Racing rules are covered in more depth, advanced boat handling skills are taught, and the use of a spinnaker and trapeze are introduced.

**420 Racing Team:** This is the highest level of junior sailing at OYC. These sailors demonstrate a keen knowledge of racing strategy and rules as well as superior boat handling skills. The team competes regularly against other Clubs in the SMSA Team Racing bracket and participates in regattas all over the SMSA region.

### **Mission Statement**

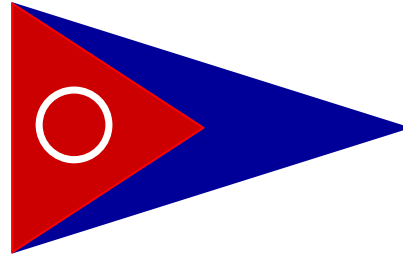

<b>WEATHER CANCELLATION POLICY:</b> The OYC reserves the right to cancel classes due to inclement weather such as thunderstorm/lightning activity or high wind/wave conditions. When poor weather conditions occur, other sailing related activities are generally put into practice. Sailing in different weather conditions is an integral part of the learning experience and many classes are conducted in the rain, so students are expected to attend classes and be dressed appropriately. In the event of class cancellation, students/parents will be notified.	
<b>REFUND POLICY:</b> No refunds/makeup classes/credit toward future classes will be given due to weather cancellations, if student fails to arrive to class, is ill, is expelled from the program, for injuries sustained prior to the start of the program or after student starts the program. Any approved refunds will be issued as follows: 50% of payments made seven (7) or more days before student starts program, 25% of payments made less than seven (7) days before student starts program. All refunds are subject to a \$25 administration charge.
